- Labels supplied by the Creative Crafts Organiser on receipt of entries, must be firmly attached to each exhibit stating the correct class exhibitor's number.
- Please specify if article is made by a **boy or a girl**.
- Articles may only be entered at the show for one year. If it is found that the article is entered again, it will be disqualified.
- **If a student is physically disabled it must be clearly indicated.**

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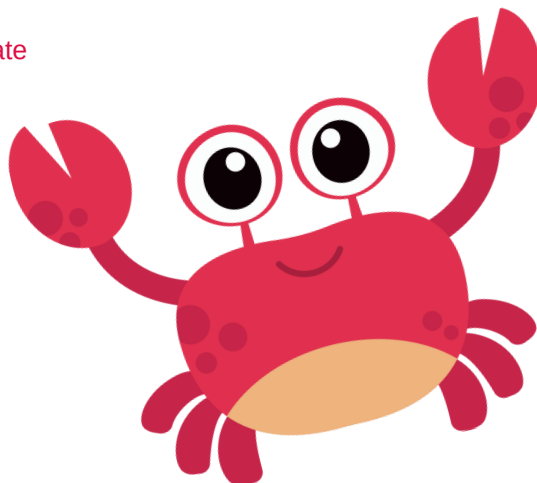
